Privanova is responsible for creating and updating the Dissemination and Communication Plan (DCP), ensuring that all activities align with the project's goals and key performance indicators.


Privanova will also coordinate the establishment of the SafeHorizon Community of Experts, a group of stakeholders who will provide feedback and guidance throughout the project.
